Boundary pushing blend of local Savagnin with Chardonnay from Jura new comers

Cullen, Margret River 2014 Amber 94

Inspired by Pheasant’s Tears this late picked, 64% Semillon, 36% Sauvignon Blanc of which 79% was fermented in new oak for four months with skins and pips included. Very vibrant and characterful.

Bio grown high up on the slopes of Mount Barker by a husband and wife team, Janet and Erinn Klein, with unexpected juiciness

Vinteloper, Lenswood Adelaide Hills 2014 'Odeon' Pinot Noir 180

Ultra-lean colour, floral, spice, tart cherry, cinnamon and dried herb. Earth wood smoked and orange rind freshness
