*Low alcohol, Italian inspired. Slightly spritzy and very floral*

*Single vineyard first planted in 2001, dry, crisp yet full*

Paracombe, Adelaide Hills NV Sparkling Pinot Noir Chardonnay 79

*Exceptional NV blend crafted from reserve wines dating back to the early 90's*

Louis Roederer, Champagne Brut Premier 300

*Yeasty richness mellowed with high acidity and baked tropical fruit*

### **Rose by the Bottle**

Jericho, Adelaide Hills 2017 Rosé 50

*A blend of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Pinot Gris. The palate has a lovely fullness of fruit flavours coming from the three varieties of Pinots and finishes with slight drying tannins and excellent balance.*

*Fruit is from the highest point of the Estate. A small amount of barrel age gives structure, depth and savoury notes*

*Pete Frasers takes on the classic Condrieu, you won't find much better in the New World*

*The key for this property is to "respect the terroir". One of the oldest Domaines in Sancerre, following Biodynamic principles too*

Peggy Buronfosse, 2012 Jura Savagnin, Chardonnay 130

*Boundary pushing blend of local Savagnin with Chardonnay from Jura new comers*

## Skin Contact by the Bottle (White)

Cullen, Margret River 2014 Amber 94

*Inspired by Pheasant's Tears this late picked, 64% Semillon, 36% Sauvignon Blanc of which 79% was fermented in new oak for four months with skins and pips included. Very vibrant and characterful.*

*Emulating the great wines Chianti, grown at altitude – 400m, in Balhannah on the Bottin vineyard*
